FOREWORD

Shoe sizes — System of length grading (for use in the Mondopoint system)

1 SCOPE AND FIELD OF APPLICATION

This International Standard establishes a system of grading of lengths for use in the Mondopoint system with a view to settling the range of boot and shoe sizes, in accordance with ISO 2816.¹⁾

This system applies to all types of boots and shoes.

2 REFERENCE

ISO 2816, *Fundamental characteristics of a system of shoe sizing to be known as Mondopoint.*

3 LENGTH INTERVALS

The length intervals upon which the Mondopoint system is based shall be 5 mm or 7,5 mm, the origin of the grade being fixed at 0.

4 METHOD OF INDICATING THE LENGTH

The indication of length in the size marking shall always be given in millimetres to the nearest whole number, rounded down where necessary.²⁾

5 TABLE OF LENGTHS

The table gives, as an illustration, all lengths between 105 and 300 mm, for use in the Mondopoint system.
