# Coated abrasives — Rolls for widths of 50 mm and greater — Any backing — Designation and dimensions

## 1 SCOPE AND FIELD OF APPLICATION

This International Standard lays down the dimensions of abrasive rolls for widths of 50 mm and greater — any backing — and specifies the designation of these rolls.

## 2 DESIGNATION

The designation of rolls for widths of 50 mm and greater consists of the width  $l$ , followed by the length  $L$ .

*Example :*

Designation of a roll of width  $l = 50$  mm and length  $L = 50\,000$  mm :

Roll 50 × 50 000

(The nature of the backing shall be indicated.)

## 3 DIMENSIONS

### 3.1 Widths $l$ (in millimetres)

50 - 100 - 120 - 150 - 200 - 300 - 600

### 3.2 Length $L$ (in millimetres)

The only length  $L$  retained is 50 000.
