Coated abrasives – Cloth rolls up to and including 40 mm width – Designation and dimensions

1 SCOPE AND FIELD OF APPLICATION

This International Standard lays down the dimensions of abrasive cloth rolls up to and including 40 mm width and specifies the designation of these rolls.

2 DESIGNATION

The designation of cloth rolls up to and including 40 mm width consists of the width l , followed by the length L .

Example :

Designation of a cloth roll of width $l = 25$ mm and length $L = 50\,000$ mm :

Cloth roll 25 X 50 000

3 DIMENSIONS

3.1 Widths l (in millimetres)

12,5 – 25 – 35 – 40

3.2 Length L (in millimetres)

The only length L retained is 50 000.
