

<p><b>Field of application</b> Signs at stations, airports and in towns. Public facilities, transport facilities.</p>	
<p><b>Context of use</b></p>	
<p><b>Intended user population</b> General population.</p>

	<p><b>Function</b> To indicate a place for tourists or tour groups to gather.</p>
	<p><b>Image content</b> Frontal view of a standing human figure holding a triangle-shaped flag and a side view of two standing human figures walking toward the figure with the flag.</p>
<p><b>Human behaviour that is intended to be caused after understanding the public information symbol's meaning</b> Finding a tour group meeting area and/or a group reception desk.</p>	
<p><b>Need</b> To indicate a designated place for tour groups to gather.</p>	
<p><b>Related meanings</b> PI PF 042.</p>	
<p><b>Field of application</b> Signs at stations, airports and in towns. Public facilities, transport facilities.</p>	
<p><b>Context of use</b></p>	
<p><b>Intended user population</b> General population.</p>	
<p><b>Age of user</b> Any.</p>	
<p><b>Additional information</b> Test data obtained according to ISO 9186-1 are available from more than one country. PI PF 074: Automatic sensor faucet or tap

	<p><b>Meaning</b> Automatic sensor faucet or tap</p>
	<p><b>Function</b> To show the location of automatic sensor faucet or tap.</p> <p><b>Image content</b> Frontal view of right hand; three dotted lines; a faucet or tap; three parallel arc lines.</p>
<p><b>Human behaviour that is intended to be caused after understanding the public information symbol's meaning</b> Understanding how to operate an automatic faucet or tap.</p>	
<p><b>Need</b> To help people understand that the faucet or tap is operated by a sensor.</p>	
<p><b>Related meanings</b></p>	
<p><b>Field of application</b> Public facilities, transport facilities, commercial facilities.</p>	
<p><b>Context of use</b> This symbol is used in a public place like a shopping mall or a plaza, and is also found in the street. Usually it can be found on a location sign in or near a toilet.</p>	
<p><b>Intended user population</b> General population.</p>	
<p><b>Age of user</b> Any.</p>	
<p><b>Additional information</b> Test data obtained according to ISO 9186-1 are available from more than one country. Findings from testing showed that the symbol exceeded the criteria of acceptability. Although not required, accompanying text may be used to increase comprehension.</p>	

PI PF 075: Hand dryer

	<b>Reference no.</b> <b>ISO 7001 – PI PF 075</b>
	<b>Meaning</b> <b>Hand dryer</b>
	<b>Function</b> To show the location of a hand dryer.
	<b>Image content</b> Frontal view of hand. Vent; three parallel wavy lines.
<b>Human behaviour that is intended to be caused after understanding the public information symbol's meaning</b> Finding a hand dryer.	
<b>Need</b> To help people find a hand dryer.	
<b>Related meanings</b>	
<b>Field of application</b> Public facilities, transport facilities, tourism, culture and heritage, commercial facilities.	
<b>Context of use</b> This symbol is used in or near a public toilet. It might be found on a location sign which shows the position of hand dryers.	
<b>Intended user population</b> General population.	
<b>Age of user</b> Any.	
<b>Additional information</b> Test data obtained according to ISO 9186-1 are not available from more than one country. Findings from national testing, however, showed that in one country the symbol exceeded the criteria of acceptability. It is recommended that this symbol is accompanied by text to increase comprehension.
