Additional information on characters

This annex contains additional information on some of the characters specified in clauses 25 and 26 of this part of ISO/IEC 10646. This information is intended to clarify some feature of a character, such as its naming or usage, or its associated graphic symbol.

Each entry in this annex consists of the name of a character and its code position in the two-octet form, followed by the related additional information. Entries are arranged in ascending sequence of code position.

When an entry for a character is included in this annex an * symbol appears immediately following its name in the corresponding table in clause 25 of 26 of this part of ISO/IEC 10646.
