Syntax of the MPQFCapabilitiesType:

Name	Definition
MPQFCapabilitiesType	Tool for describing the ISO/IEC 15938-12 capabilities a terminal is capable to provide.
MPQFCapability	Describes the ISO/IEC 15938-12 capabilities of a particular service a terminal is capable to provide. NOTE The service is identified by the serviceID attribute of the mpqf:AvailableCapabilityType.
