BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 328, *Size of Picture Postcards and of Lettercards*, was drawn up by Technical Committee ISO/TC 6, *Paper*, the Secretariat of which is held by the Association Française de Normalisation (AFNOR).

Work on this question by the Technical Committee began in 1960 and led, in 1961, to the adoption of a Draft ISO Recommendation.

In May 1962, this Draft ISO Recommendation (No. 506) was circulated to all the ISO Member Bodies for enquiry. It was approved by the following Member Bodies:

Four Member Bodies opposed the approval of the Draft:

Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, United Kingdom.

The Draft ISO Recommendation was then submitted by correspondence to the ISO Council, which decided, in August 1963, to accept it as an ISO RECOMMENDATION.

SIZE OF PICTURE POSTCARDS AND OF LETTERCARDS *

For dispatch through the post, it is recommended that the following size should be used for illustrated postcards and letter cards:

A6** = 105 mm × 148 mm

Tolerances:

upper deviation + 1.5 mm

lower deviation - 1.5 mm
