## BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 337, *Semi-Trailer Fifth Wheel Kingpin*, was drawn up by Technical Committee ISO/TC 22, *Automobiles*, the Secretariat of which is held by the Association Française de Normalisation (AFNOR).

Work on this question by the Technical Committee began in 1958 and led, in 1960, to the adoption of a Draft ISO Recommendation.

In April 1961, this Draft ISO Recommendation (No. 444) was circulated to all the ISO Member Bodies for enquiry. It was approved by the following Member Bodies:
