BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 42, *Mushroom Ventilators*, was drawn up by the Technical Committee ISO /TC 9, *Shipbuilding Details for Inland Navigation*, the Secretariat of which is held by the Hoofdcmissie voor de Normalisatie in Nederland (H.C.N.N.).

At its initial meeting, held in Paris, June 1949, the Technical Committee unanimously decided to adopt a proposal which had been drawn up in 1937 by the former International Federation of the National Standardizing Associations (ISA).

The draft proposal drawn up on that basis was submitted by correspondence to the members of the Technical Committee and adopted as a Draft ISO Recommendation.

In December 1954, the Draft ISO Recommendation proposed by the Technical Committee ISO /TC 9 was submitted to all the ISO Member Bodies. It was approved, subject to some editorial amendments, by the following 26 (out of a total of 36) Member Bodies:


