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BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 545, *Lengths and Tolerance for Filler Rods, Other than Drawn or Extruded, for Welding* was drawn up by Technical Committee ISO/TC 44, *Welding*, the Secretariat of which is held by the Association française de Normalisation (AFNOR).

Work on this question by the Technical Committee began in 1955 and led, in 1957, to the adoption of a Draft ISO Recommendation.

In September 1958, this Draft ISO Recommendation (No. 229) was circulated to all the ISO Member Bodies for enquiry. It was approved, subject to a few modifications of an editorial nature, by the following Member Bodies:
