Intermediate Modulus
9/16 in. (14 mm), 0.08 to 0.13 oz per yd (2.5 to 4.0 g/m)

1. SCOPE:

- 1.1 Form: This specification covers four classes of para-aramid tape and webbing of a single width and with varying weights.
- 1.2 Application: Primarily for use in cargo type parachutes.
- 1.3 Classification: Width of 9/16 in. \pm 1/16 (14 mm \pm 1.5) and two weight classes as follows:

1	0.08	2.5
2	0.13	4.0

2. APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS: See AMS 3793.

3. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 3.1 Basic Specification: The complete requirements for procuring the tape and webbing described herein shall consist of this document and the latest issue of the basic specification, AMS 3793.
- 3.2 Properties: Tape and webbing shall conform to the requirements of Table I and the following:
- 3.2.1 Width: Shall be 9/16 in. \pm 1/16 (14 mm \pm 1.5).
- 3.2.2 Weight: Shall be as specified in 1.3 for the class ordered.

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
