1-1/2 Inches (37.5 mm), 0.12 to 0.47 Ounces per Yard (3.7 to 14.6 g/m)

RATIONALE

This document has been determined to contain basic and stable technology which is not dynamic in nature.

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1. SCOPE:

1.1 Form:

This specification covers three classes of para-aramid tape and webbing of a single width and with varying weights.

1.2 Application:

See AMS 3793.

1.3 Classification:

Width of 1-1/2 inches $\pm$ 1/16 (37.5 mm $\pm$ 1.6) and weight classes as shown in Table 1.
