1. SCOPE:

1.1 Form:

This specification covers one type of low-contrast, coarse-grain radiographic film in the form of cut sheets or rolls.

1.2 Application:

This film will provide a radiographic quality level of 2-2T sensitivity when properly utilized (See AMS 7295).

1.3 Classification:

Low contrast with gradient of 3.0 to 3.9 and exhibiting resolution of 20 to 39 lines per millimeter.

2. APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS:

See AMS 7295.

3. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

3.1 Basic Specification:

The complete requirements for film described herein and its procurement shall consist of this document and the latest issue of the basic specification, AMS 7295.

3.1.1 Definition: Properties shall be as defined in AMS 7295.
