Cable, Power, Electrical, Portable General Specification For

1. Present Requirement: 3.4.1 Conductors: Table I, Page 6
Not required

Change Requirement: 3.4.1 Conductors: Table I, Page 6
Add to the column 3 header, "Lay-up of strands", the footnote symbol "2".
Add at the bottom of Table I, "2/ Other stranding constructions may be used provided they contain the minimum number of strands, and are of equivalent flexibility".

2. Present Requirement: 3.6 Identification of product: Page 10, First Sentence
All cables manufactured in accordance with this specification shall be identified by surface printing.

Change Requirement: 3.6 Identification of product: Page 10, First Sentence
All cables shall be identified by surface printing on the outside of the jacket or combined insulation and jacket in addition to any marker tape which may be used".

3. Present Requirement: 3.6 Identification of product: Page 10, second paragraph
"Military specification part number of the cable" (see 3.1)

Change Requirement: 3.6 Identification of product: Page 10, second paragraph
"Military specification part number of the cable" (see 3.1) except the dash number is not required to be printed on the surface of the cable".
