Safety Labels of Off-Road Work Machines		

RATIONALE

Some of the referenced ISO standards have been revised so that the term “safety sign” has been changed to “safety label” to align with normative references in those referenced ISO standards. The use of “safety sign” in the text should be changed to “safety label” accordingly. Terms and definitions need to be revised to align with the terms and definitions in the referenced ISO standards.

1. SCOPE

SAE J115 specifies the relevant ISO standards for application to safety labels for use on off-road work machines as defined in SAE J1116.
